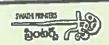

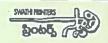
ii. The Governing Body resolved to convey it's thanks to the JNT University-Kakinada for arranging faculty selections/ratification of services of existing faculty

Subsequently, after detailed deliberation on various issues the Governing Body collectively suggested the following measure and actions for improving the functioning of the college.

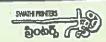
7.1 Recommendation of Governing Body Chairman Dr.C.D.Malleswar

- > He suggested to encourage the students for startups and entrepreneurship.
- > He suggested that the students should acquire the skills which are required to the companies/industries to meet the challenges in competitive market

7.2 Recommendation of Vice-Chairman of Governing Body-Dr.L.Rathaigh

- > He suggested to go for NBA instead of NAAC
- > He suggested to introduce Value Added Programmes to UG and PG students to enhance the system knowledge
- > He advised to recruit at least 1 doctorate in each department from IITs/NITs to get good research output.
- > He suggested improving the admissions of EEE and Mechanical Engineering by promoting scope of the courses in class room itself.

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 - > He expressed that due to present market scenario, many B. Tech and M. Tech graduates will turn towards teaching. So, the aforementioned course might be useful for the students' future.
 - > He suggested to give special incentives to staff who endured excellent results in the academic year 2017-18
 - > He suggested organizing Faculty Development Programme on NBA Accreditation.
 - > He advised to not offer any research honorarium for paid publications in journals.

7.3 Recommendation of Dr. P. V. G. D. Prasad Reddy:

- > He suggested to arrange guest lectures with adjunct faculty from NITs & IITs those who are less than 70 years age.
- > He appreciate the results of EEE Department as it's crucial to get the high results in EEE in the present scenario.
- > He suggested to place the direction boards in the campus.
- > He suggested to improve the workshops and faculty publication in Scopus Indexed Journals.
- > He suggested to encourage the newly joined faculty to target for quick completion of Ph.D
- > He suggested to prepare staff appraisal policy for the academic year 2018-19 and create awareness on the policy to all staff for effective results.

7.4 Recommendation of Sri. Venkata Rayulu Bonam:

- ➤ He suggested to arrange on campus drives in association with APITA.
- > He opined that only training will not help students, the faculty should train the students in in-debth programmes.
- > He suggested to encourage the students for more certification programmes.
- > He suggested to do an innovative projects by IV B.Tech students with help of the faculty.
- > He expressed his unhappiness about the programme writing by the CSE and IT students of Engineering Colleges and suggested to improve the programme writing skills of the students.

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7.5 Recommendation of Dr. B.Subba Rao:

- > He said that the faculty should feel that the teaching is passionate to every faculty.
- > He opined that every student should have knowledge on fundamentals of core subjects.
- > He suggested to encourage the students for startups and advised to create awareness among the students about the Government schemes and subsidies for startups.
- > He expresses happiness upon the retention of staff members by providing them ample facilities.

7.6 Recommendation of Smt.P.Aruna Kumari

- > She suggested to improve the MoU's with industries and try to have MoU's with JNTUK to improve the placements.
- > She advised the faculty to do NPTEL Certificate Programmes.
- > She opined that the counseling of students will help for great results in academic and placements.

Principal Dr.J.Sudhakar thanked all the members for sparing their valuable time and offering valuable suggestions. He requested for their continued cooperation and support in future also.

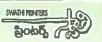
