Subsequently, after detailed deliberation on various issues the Governing Body collectively suggested the following measure and actions for improving the functioning of the college.

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7.1 Recommendations of Governing Body Chairman Dr.B.Subba Rao

- He suggested to mandate students to speak in English on regular mode in the campus
- He advised to improve research activities and encourage the staff by giving incentives for their academic excellence and research contributions through a proposal prepared by Principal
- He suggested that the faculty should be training continuously to make ready the student to meet the expectation of recruiters.

7.2 Recommendations of Dr. P. V. G. D. Prasad Reddy:

- He suggested to guide the students to pursue more value added courses to strengthening their technical skills
- He suggested to develop Community Development Programmes (CDP) in Rural, Tribal and Urban areas with support of the students through a central coordinator of the Institute which creates social responsibility among the students.

7.3 Recommendations of Dr. L. Rathaiah:

- He opined that public accreditation is required to improve the admissions and advised to make sure that a girl students should give first priority to join in VIEW instead of other college.
- He advised to train the students to get high salary package in campus selections. He also mentioned that a minimum of 20-25 students should get 15-20 lakhs annual package and the students count should increase year by year.
- He suggested focusing on schemes offered by DST & other funding agencies for women faculty and girl students.
- He advised to conduct special test especially on Mathematics to test the logical skills of students.
- He advised to make the students strong in domain knowledge, communication skills and coding skills.

7.4 Recommendations of Dr.Archana Sharma

- She opined that core branch "Mechanical Engineering" should not be closed.
- She also opined that there is a great demand for AI&ML course. Hence she advised the students to have knowledge on emerging courses.
- He suggested to encourage the students to pursue "Certification Programs during summer vacation.

7.5 Recommendations of Dr.P.Arana Kumari

- She suggested to conduct IOT workshop to students to increase analysis skills in their projects.

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- She suggested to avoid training for 1st year onwards as they feel stress in the first year. Instead of this she advised to give training to improve their communication skills.
- She suggested to encourage faculty to attend Workshops & FDPs sponsored by premier technical institutions.
- She opined that Block Chain Technology can be replaced by AI
- suggested to organize FDPs in college in association with E & ICT Academy, NIT Warangal.

7.6 Recommendations of Dr.Rishi Verma

- He suggested to prepare annual training calendar and conduct the training classes accordingly.
- He advised to keep dedicated faculty in T&P cell to look into training activities.
- He suggested to initiate activities under ISTE chapter and advised to get association/membership with IEEE women chapter, ACM women chapter.
- He advised to staff to apply FDP under ATAL FDP scheme also encourage the students to participate in the activities are being organised as a part of "Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav"
- He suggested undertaking MoU with Edu-skills and encourage students for higher education.
- He suggested to conduct GATE classes in Campus by the faculty and also recommended additional Financial benefit to them.

7.7 Recommendations of Mr.Suresh Kumar Tankala

- He advised to conduct workshop for 3 weeks on Python Programming to CSE/IT students.
- He also advised to concentrate on other emerging technologies like iOS programming language, Android App Development, Microsoft Azure and conduct workshops for 2 to 3 weeks for these courses.
- He opined that C & Python skills are not sufficient to get placement with high package.
- He also advised to plan 3-4 week workshop on UI/UX design, Full Stack Developing and events under NASSCOM.

7.8 Recommendations of Mr.Appa Rao Mogili

- He advised to conduct workshop on Python GUI Frameworks, React Java Script for at-least 1 week.
- He advised to prepare the academic calendar by considering all the above workshops and plan accordingly to conduct these activities.

- GB opined to improve innovative projects. Suggested to identify students with ability to do research ideas which can be used for industry.
- GB advised to train the faculty with industry expert and improve consultancy projects through Industry Institute Collaboration (IIC).
- GB advised to put more efforts to reach the institutional goals and maintain quality in admissions.
- GB suggested to continue the students scholarship schemes (Merit & Means) also advised to provide seed money to encourage innovate project.
- GB suggested to offer incentives to staff for research projects, academic achievements and placements.
