

#### Mechanism of Grievance Redressal Cell

#### (i) Grievances Redressal Cell (GRC)

As per All India Council for Technical Education Establishment of Mechanism for Grievance Redressal Regulations, 2012, F. No. 37-3/Legal/2012, dated 25.05.2012. Vignan's Institute of Engineering for Women is committed to providing a harmonious & fair learning environment. Students and Staff have access to processes that allow for appeals, complaints and grievances that are to be resolved. Student and staff grievance resolution process seeks to facilitate their formal resolution of grievances as close as possible to the source of the aggrieved person's dissatisfaction, though there will be instances when either students may choose to lodge a formal appeal or a grievance needs to go to a higher authority for resolution.

The institute has the following mechanism to analyze the grievances.

1.Suggestion boxes are placed on all corridors in the Institute to lodge the feedback/complaint/suggestion of all stakeholders.

- 2. The committee should meet once in a month to investigate the complaints raised by students and staff, if any.
- 3. The duty of Grievance Redressal Cell is to provide a fair representation for all the concerned parties.
- 3. During the course of the investigation, the investigator will maintain careful notes of interviews with the aggrieved member and relevant witnesses.
- 4. In addition to the written statements and testimony of the student and the faculty member, the committee may collect and consider any information it deems relevant and hear from anyone it deems to have relevant information. Both the student and faculty member may suggest the names of persons with relevant information, but the committee makes the final decision about whom to interview.
- 5. The proceedings and the committee's deliberations will be confidential and not to be open to the public.
- 6. After investigation upon grievances received, the committee members prepare a report and forwarded to Principal for further action.
- 7. Thereafter, the principal on reviewing and understanding the level of the problem forwards the same to the management committee for necessary action.

# (iii) Women Grievance & Anti-Sexual Harassment Committee/Cell (WG & ASHC):

A Women Grievance & Anti-sexual Harassment committee is established in the college to ensure safe and healthy working environment for the female students and staff. The cell plays dual role. The Cell is required to work in the direction of providing help to any female complaining of discrimination, either gender discrimination or otherwise, any kind of abuse, loneliness, peer pressure, groupism, home sickness, insecurity and/or inferiority complex in terms of physical appearance, hostel issues, harassment from room-mates, adjusting and adopting to the new environment etc.

The Cell also deals with issues relating to sexual harassment at the college as per the guidelines of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2013. It is applicable to all students, staff and faculty. The following is also sexual harassment and is covered by the committee:

- Eve-teasing, Unsavory remarks,
- Jokes causing or likely to cause awkwardness or embarrassment,
- Innuendos and taunts, Gender based insults or sexist remarks,
- Unwelcome sexual overtone in any manner such as over telephone (obnoxious telephone calls) and the like,
- Touching or brushing against any part of the body and the like,
- Displaying pornographic or other offensive or derogatory pictures, cartoons, pamphlets or sayings,
- Forcible physical touch or molestation and Physical confinement against one's will and any other act likely to violate one's privacy.

#### Mechanism for complaints on Sexual Harassment:

A written complaint is required to be taken from the aggrieved person, necessary action to be taken, preferably to settle the matter through counselling and conciliation as soon as possible. In case the matter is not so sorted, inquiry to be conducted and matter to be sorted out within 10 days from the date of compliant. The members to be vigilant all the time and ensure that there is no such incident taking place in campus by creating awareness and having an open dialogue with all the students. Following are the Guidelines to be strictly followed

- The complainant will have to submit a written and signed complaint addressed to the Presiding officer of the Cell
- The students/staff can give a complainant through e-mail to womengrievance.view@gmail.com
- The counselor will call the complainant for a personal meeting, usually within a week from the submission of the written complaint
- The members of the Cell will discuss the complaint
- If the case falls outside the purview of the Cell, the complainant will be informed to Director
- If the case comes under the purview of the Cell, an enquiry committee will be set up
- The Committee will submit a report and recommend the nature of action to be taken at the earliest by Director
- If any legal action is required with the help of advocate member of the cell complaint is forwarded to police.

#### **Placement Facilities:**

Globalization has brought in a clear shift from education as transmission of expert knowledge to education as building learner competencies. Keeping in pace, *Vignan's Institute of Engineering for Women* (VIEW) too have set their priorities as being a prime aide in employment generation for their students.

Pre-placement training at institute was developed to enhance the student's skills such as communication skills, soft skills, personality development skills and technical skills through outcome based education. A coordinating team with faculty representatives from each department was constituted to execute the process at the micro-level. The Coordinating Team was earmarked to report to the Campus T&P cell in-charge and maintain a close liaison with the students on the other hand.

The campus T&P team had refurbished the complete training process making a few vital changes with three distinct components Aptitude, Technical and Verbal training & Soft Skills training.

The recommendations or the suggestions given by the employers and program coordinator will be taken in to the consideration while designing the Pre-Placement Training Calendar and it will be circulated among all the departments for circulations.

# Implementation of Pre-Placement Training:

Post designing the Pre-Placement Training Calendar, a defined procedure will be implemented for executing the Pre-Placement Training.

- From 2<sup>nd</sup> year onwards two non-credit courses to be implemented such as:
  - 1. Aptitude Training Through Reference globe LMS (Life Time Access)
  - 2. Technical Training (Core & Programming Skills) Through Reference globe & HackerRank
- Before IV B.Tech, undertaking forms will be issued to all the students for their consent towards training.
- Students reporting those who are not willing will be forwarded to Careers Guidance Cell through TPO.
- Students who accepted the undertaking, training will be processed through the following modules;
- 1. Campus Recruitment Training (Eligibility: above 60% aggregate in academics / special cases recommended by program coordinator through principal if any)
  - i. Product Development Training.
  - ii. Application Oriented Training.
- 2. Company Specific Training (as per the eligibility & JD)
- 3. Professional Internships (Through Campus hiring / Internshala)
- 4. Specialized Training (If any concerns from Principal/Careers Guidance Cell/Program Coordinator)

A special target based strategy was further introduced for the T & P team to ensure a steady inflow of opportunities for all the years round for all the branches; as a result

there was a 42.17 percent increase from 2017-18 to 2020-21 in the number of jobs offered **in the Core Profile jobs**.

The placement seasons for MBA 2021 too saw a diverse mix of companies spread across various domains and functions, offering niche roles to them, recording an all-time high placement.

The admissions to the institute are made as per rules/regulations framed by the Andhra Pradesh Government/AICTE. The AP Government test agency is Department of Technical Education, Competitive Examination Conducted named as EAMCET. The website address is http://apeamcet.nic.in

Number of seats allotted to different Test Qualified candidates separately [AIEEE/CET (State conducted test/University tests)/Association conducted test]

The seats are allotted as per the quota and norms set by JNTU Kakinada, to which VIEW is affiliated.

#### Calendar for admission against management/vacant seats:

- Last date for request for applications.
- Last date for submission of application.
- Dates for announcing final results.
- Release of admission list (main list and waiting list should be announced on the same day)
- Date for acceptance by the candidate (time given should in no case be less than 15 days)
- Last date for closing of admission.

#### XI. CRETERIA AND WEIGHTAGES FOR ADMISSION

#### **Eligibility Criteria for Admission to B.Tech Courses:**

The minimum qualification for admission to first year of the B.Tech course is a pass in the Intermediate (10 + 2) conducted by the board of Intermediate education, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry as optional subjects.

- 70 % of the seats are allotted based on the merit in the Engineering, Agriculture and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (EAPCET) conducted by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.
- 30 % of the seats are earmarked for Management Quota candidates.
- In addition to the above, Diploma holders are admitted in second year of B.Tech to the extent of 10% of intake based on the merit in the Engineering Common Entrance Test (ECET), under lateral entry scheme conducted by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.

#### The Eligibility Criteria for Admission to M.Tech Courses:

The minimum qualification for admission into M.Tech is a pass in B.E / B.Tech in concern stream.

- 70% of the seats are allotted based on GATE score / rank obtained in PGECET for M.Tech Course.
- 30 % of the seats are earmarked for Management Quota candidates.

# The Eligibility Criteria for Admission to MBA Course:

The minimum qualification for admission to first year of the MBA is a pass in undergraduate course (10 + 2 + 3).

- 70% of the seats are allotted based on the merit in the Integrated Common Entrance Test (ICET) conducted by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.
- 30% of the seats are earmarked for Management Quota candidates.

#### A. Library Facility

The central Library is a proud partner in the Institute's march towards its vision playing a vital role in acquisition, organization and dissemination of knowledge. The main thrust of the library continues to be the improvement of the quality of services and facilities, achieving higher degree of user's satisfaction and modernization of its activities and operations. The Central Library is totally Air Conditioned, presently covers a total user area of 571.91 sq. mtrs, with a seating capacity of 175 and caters to the information needs of the faculty, staff and students. The Central Library has Text book section, Circulation section, Reference books, Periodical Section with rich collection of Journals and books. The separate departmental libraries are establishment in each department for quick access purpose in addition to the central library.

# **Library Collection:**

The Vignana Vahini Library has a huge collection of 28419 books with 5940 titles on various subjects including technical, managerial and humanities and reference books covering biographies, dictionaries, yearbooks etc. The library subscribes 116 National, International print journals and Magazines, 5230 e-journals, and holds over 1018 project reports. The Learning materials, Previous Question Papers, Project Reports of all departments are made available

#### Library e-Resources:

The Digital Library has 20 computers and several E- Resource of e-journals, e-books, video lectures (like NPTEL), audio lectures of various publisher are made available in the Digital Library for effective teaching learning process.

# Library Automation and Security:

The Central Library employs Barcode technology for access control, automatic issue and return of library books. Automation of library services enables library staff to assist the students for more time in their search for quality learning resources.

# Relevance and availability of learning resources:

The procurement of the books is decided based on the library advisory committee which consists of all the departments. Selected students from III and IV year of Engineering are also members of the library advisory committee.
